If you are making **monthly payments** towards your taxes, please adjust your budget as the garbage charges have moved from the Utility billings to the **Residential Taxes.**

Section 4 of Bylaw No. 490/15:

Costs associated with residential waste and recycling collection service shall be incorporated into the annual residential municipal property taxes as a service provided by the Town through its appointed waste collection provider.

Do you own a dog?

If you own a dog in the Town of Spiritwood, your dog must be **licensed ANNUALLY**. The cost is \$25.00 per year. Pets that are lost can easily be identified if wearing a tag. The owner will also avoid a fine.
