Snow Obstructions & Plowing

Please remember that when you are plowing your snow that it should not be pushed into ditches or onto culverts. This makes spring thaw very difficult and will cause flooding to the town. As well when making snow piles, please try not to obstruct intersections.

Business Licenses

If you hire contractors & businesses from outside of town they are required to have a business license to work within town limits. This includes plumbers, electricians, builders, heating etc. Licensees are purchased at Town Office.

False Fire Alarms

False fire alarms within the Town of Spiritwood will lead to charges. When Fire Fighters are dispatched to a residence and it is found to be a false alarm, the following rules apply in each calendar year:

- 1) the first false alarm call-out will be no charge,
- 2) and any additional false alarm call outs will be charged the firefighters hourly rate with a minimum three-hour call-out plus a \$5 administration fee.
