Town of Spiritwood - Transfer Site Tipping Fees

Rates Effective April 30, 2019

Roll-Off Bin Pricing

1. Minimum Charge for Unsorted Household Waste:

Vehicle Trunk	\$30.00	Single Axle Trailer	\$75.00
¼ Ton Truck	\$45.00	Double Axle Trailer	\$150.00
½ Ton Truck	\$55.00	Tandem Dump Truck	\$200.00

2. Large items of Furniture:

Small Chair	\$10.00	Sofa	\$40.00
Single Bed	\$20.00	All other beds	\$40.00

3. Minimum Charge for Construction Waste:

Vehicle Trunk	\$30.00	Single Axle Trailer	\$90.00
¼ Ton Truck	\$50.00	Double Axle Trailer	\$175.00
½ Ton Truck	\$65.00	Tandem Dump Truck	\$250.00

4. Shingles are accepted in the roll-off bin at the following rates:

- Town residents \$500 per house
- Out-of-Town \$800 per house

5. Plumbing Fixtures such as sinks, toilets & shower stalls. **\$35.00 each**
These items are put in the roll-off bin. *METAL BATHTUBS GO IN THE METAL PILE*

Misc. Item Pricing

6. Refrigeration Appliances such as refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners, water coolers.
These items are put on pile marked by sign. Freon must be removed. **\$35.00 each**

7. Appliances **not** related to refrigeration such as stoves, microwaves and items such as bikes, lawn mowers, rototillers, snow blowers, dryers.
All these items are put on pile which is marked by a sign. **\$10.00 each**

8. Metal is NOT allowed in roll-off bin – there is a designated Metal Pile. **\$20 per ½ ton truck load**

9. Concrete is not allowed in roll-off bin – Charges for concrete is as follows:

½ Ton or Trailer	\$30	Tandem Dump Truck	\$100
1 Ton Truck	\$40	Semi-Trailer	\$175
3 Ton Truck	\$60		

Free Items

10. Sorted Compostable Material such as grass, leaves, clean soil, garden vines.

These items are put on the compost pile loosely which is marked by a sign, must NOT be bagged or in container.

11. Wood Products for Burning (ONLY branches or non-treated, un-painted wood with NO nails)

These items go on the burn pile marked by a sign.

12. Grain Bags will only be accepted if they are baled, and these items go in their designated area.

13. AA, AAA, C, D & 9 volt batteries are accepted at the Town Office.

The following materials will **NOT** be accepted at the Transfer Site:

| - No hazardous materials (No truck/car wash sumpage) | - No vehicle batteries (accepted at ECO center) |
| - No contaminated soils | - No Propane tanks or Fuel tanks |
| - No asbestos | - No chemical containers |
| - No animal carcasses | - No electronics (accepted at SARCAN) |
| - No grain of any type | - No paint |
| - No oil, filters or oil jugs (accepted at the ECO Center - <u>no oil that is mixed w/ water or antifreeze</u>) | - No tires (take to a business that sells tires/pay enviro fee) |

Landfill Rules and Regulations:

- Unload only in area designated by transfer site personnel
- The Town will not accept liability for vehicle damage or personal injury at the transfer site
- No vehicle bodies or vehicle parts will be accepted
- Leaves, grass and garden vines must be removed from the plastic bags
- No burning allowed
