



2023 Budget Summary

The Saskatchewan Ministry of Education set the mill rates for school taxes as follows with no change from the previous year:

2023 Education Property Tax Mill Rates	
Agricultural	1.42
Residential	4.54
Commercial	6.86

Council has adjusted the tax mill rate this year to reduce the impact on property owners with a nominal overall increase. Your municipal taxes pay for fundamental municipal services such as fire protection, policing, street maintenance/snow removal, recreation facilities, water and sewer maintenance, library services, planning and development services, environmental services, and municipal administration costs. Council sets direction of the community by prioritizing capital projects, infrastructure maintenance (both current and future) and the health, safety and welfare of its residents.

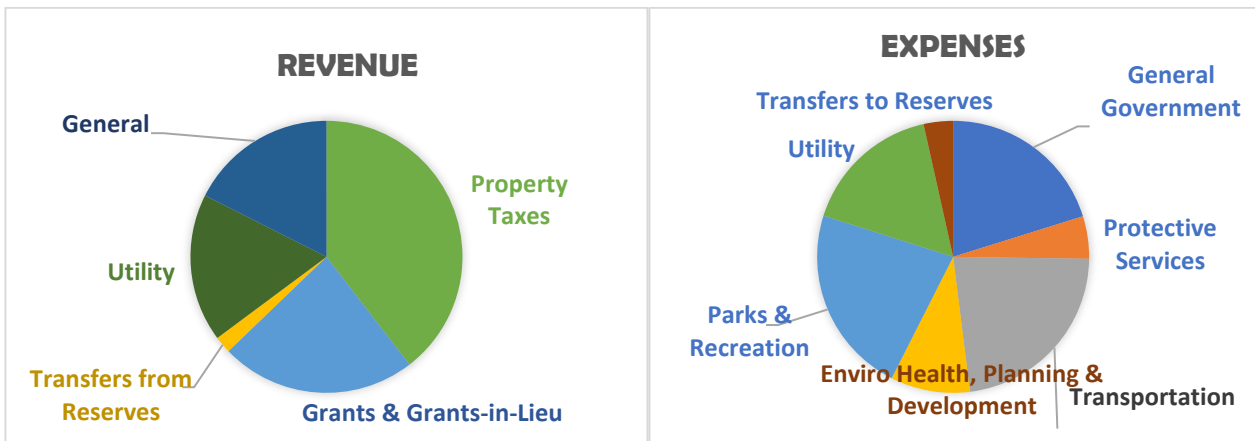
