CUTTING GRASS

It is the responsibility of the property owner to make sure the grass is mown regularly including the perimeters and back alley. Any lawns exceeding a height of 0.20 meters is considered overgrown.

ATV USE

ATVs (All Terrain Vehicles) must take the most direct route to or from the point of origin or destination within Town limits. The operator must hold a valid Driver's License and wear a helmet as prescribed by the *All Terrain Vehicles Act*. While driving within the Town of Spiritwood the speed limit for ATVs is 24km/h. They are NOT to be operated between the hours of 11:00 PM and 7:00 AM.



SEWER SYSTEM

Do NOT flush wipes, napkins or feminine products down the toilet. Even the ones that say they are flushable are NOT! They plug up the sewer main and cause issues for the pumps.
